

Web Based Research

Diigo is a social bookmarking and annotation tool to help students in their research and to take notes about web-based content electronically.

Diigo allows you to highlight and annotate web page. This helps to mark the important information in articles, and prioritize different portions with different colours as you would do in a piece of paper. You can also bookmark web pages and use sticky notes as tags to put in your thoughts for remembering the next time you go to the web page to retrieve information. It also provides you with a library, where you can go to see what pages you have bookmarked, your notes, and your highlighted items.

Download and Installation:

To download Diigo, go to: <http://www.diigo.com/>, click on 'Get Started Now'. You will be asked to fill in your details and create an account. A message will be sent to your e-mail account for activation. Once your account has been activated, you will be re-directed to 'Get in your browser web store now' and 'Install'.

Afterwards, you will see a Diigo icon on your browser.

Use of Diigo:

When you click on Diigo icon in your browser, you will see different highlight, bookmark and sharing options. Each of them has special features to help you take notes and use them afterwards when you are writing a report or research document. The highlight option allows you to highlight important lines in a web page, or any news that you want to share with friends or colleagues. You can add sticky notes as tags beside the highlighted ones to help you record your comments for the next time you visit the page.

When you bookmark a web page, you can tag it with the keywords in the tags section, and it gets added to your library. You can browse your library from any computer by logging into the Diigo website. You can also choose to read the page later or take a snapshot of the web page. When you go to the library you can see both the html page and snapshot.

With the Diigo toolbar, you can share your bookmarked and annotated web pages on Twitter, Facebook or send them to a friend or to group members. Sharing is easy with Diigo!
